Richard Notkin is perhaps the most noted and widely anthologized ceramic artist working with slipcasting techniques. He is noted for developing a personal aesthetic and vision. The recipient of both Guggenheim and Tiffany Foundations' fellowships, he has also received three fellowship awards from the National Endowment for the Arts. His ceramic teapots and sculptures have been exhibited internationally and are included in the prestigious collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, The Smithsonian Institution, and the Los Angeles County Museum of Art. He has been an active artist and teacher involved with ceramics for over 35 years.

## workshop:

November 13-14

Richard Notkin will conduct a workshop, *Ceramic Sculpture: Concept and Technique*, beginning with a Gallery Talk and slide presentation on Friday, November 12. The workshop will focus on developing a philosophy and a personal aesthetic for sculpture and vessel making. On Saturday and Sunday, November 13 and 14, Notkin will work with the participants on a hands-on project, and will demonstrate mold-making and plaster mold techniques, and large-scale carving and altering methods. The workshop cost is \$250 and includes snacks and lunch. College credit through Colorado Mountain College may be available, and scholarships will be available.

#### **General Requirements**

- Open to all artists 18 years or older.
- Artists may enter up to 3 pieces.
- Work must be artist's original composition, made within the last 3 years.
- No work shown in prior exhibitions in the galleries at the Eleanor Bliss Center for the Arts may be entered.
- Entries are juried by slide submissions. Cash award recipients will be selected by the exhibit judge after the installation of the show and prior to the opening.
- Artist statement and/or bio must be provided with entry.
- All works will be insured while on the premises for 70% of the stated price of the work.
- Entries may not be removed before the end of the show.
- The SSAC reserves the right to final curatorial, educational, publicity and installation decisions.

#### Sale of Artwork

- All artwork must be for sale at the price indicated on the entry form.
- The SSAC will retain a 30% commission on all sales.

#### **Entry Fees & Slides**

- All fees are non-refundable and must be included with the Entry Form.
- Fees for SSAC Artist Level members: \$25 for up to 3 pieces.
- Fees for non-members: \$30 for up to 3 pieces.
- Make checks payable to Steamboat Springs Arts Council.
- All artwork will be juried from 35mm slides in 2"x2" mounts only. Each piece may be represented with two slides.
- Slides must be clearly labeled with name, title, size and medium. Indicate TOP of slide with an arrow. Mark with entry number that corresponds with Entry Form.
- Please remember that the quality of your slides can greatly influence a judge's decision.
- Please include an adequately sized self-addressed stamped envelope with correct postage, for notification of acceptance/decline and return of slides.
- SSAC may decline work that is not accurately represented by its slide.

### **Artwork Delivery and Shipping**

- Hand-delivered artwork will be accepted at the Steamboat Springs Arts Council on Tuesday, November 9, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.
- Shipped artwork must arrive November 1 − 5.
- The artist will incur all shipping costs, round trip.
